This Indenture, made on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March AD One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety Seven, between Joel Reed  
Trustee of the County of Cabarrus and State of North Carolina,  
on the one part, and J. M. Coley of the County of Cabarrus and  
State of North Carolina on the other part; Witnesseth: That whereas  
by virtue of a certain deed of trust made by one James Kring-  
inger & wife Milly to the said Joel Reed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of  
December AD One Thousand, Eight hundred and Eighty  
Three, to secure the payment of a debt of Three Hundred and  
Two ~~94~~ Dollars, and interest, due to the said Joel Reed as will  
fully appear on reference being had to the said deed, the  
conditions of which not being complied with, the said Joel  
Reed Trustee did, according to the said conditions, expose  
to public sale the property therein mentioned and thereby  
conveyed, that is to say, one tract of land hereinafter  
particularly described, and the said J. M. Coley being the  
last and highest bidder at the sum of Two hundred and  
fifty Dollars, became the lawful purchaser; Now, Therefore,  
this indenture witnesseth, that the said Joel Reed Trustee  
for and in consideration of the said sum of Two Hun-  
dred and Twenty five Dollars to him in hand paid by the  
said J. M. Coley, the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged,  
hath given, granted, bargained and sold, and by these  
present doth give, grant, bargain and sell unto the said  
J. M. Coley all the aforesaid tract or parcel of land lying  
and being in the said County of Cabarrus and State of North  
Carolina, situated on the waters of Irish Buffalo Creek,  
bounded as follows, viz: All that tract of land adjoining  
Ned Benton, Jos White & others, containing about 60 acres.  
More or less is the same tract of land which C. B. Barringer  
& wife conveyed to W. A. Oechard excepting however from said  
lands all those portions or lots which <sup>had</sup> heretofore been sold &  
conveyed to the African Church, Ned Benton, Cannons & Fetzer  
Alex Alexander, School House & others; The lands intended  
to be conveyed are now in possession of said J. M. Coley, and  
reference is here made to all prior deeds for full and  
complete boundaries, not only to this tract, but to any  
of those heretofore sold to other parties; The tract here  
conveyed, is supposed to contain Twenty acres, be the same  
more or less; To have and to hold the said tract of land,  
together with all and singular the woods, ways, waters, minerals,  
improvements, privileges and appurtenances  
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him.
